

How to install "Bibliobitternes Ø"

It's easy to install the app "Bibliobitternes Ø" on both iOS and Android. The app is developed for tablets, but it also works on smartphones.

The app is currently a prototype and therefore isn't published normally in App Store or Google Play. Instead, you can install the app by doing the following:

iOS

First download the free app TestFlight from the App Store. It's used for installing the prototype app.

Then, visit the link testflight.apple.com/join/LjGiG8EHon on your phone or scan the QR code with your camera.

You can now open the link in TestFlight and accept becoming a tester of "Bibliobitternes Ø". You can then install the app, and you can open it from your iPhone or iPad like a normal app.

(The app needs permission to use the camera to work correctly)



Android

Visit the link play.google.com/apps/testing/dk.herlev.biblioteksorientering on your phone or tablet or scan the QR code with a QR scanner. You will be asked to log in with your Google Account.

You will now get the opportunity of becoming a tester of "Bibliobitternes Ø". Then, you can install the app and open it from your Android phone or tablet like a normal app.

Markers

The app won't work without AR markers. You can find them in a PDF at projektbank.dk/augmented-reality-i-biblioteket. Print them in colours and cut them to size. They can be printed in any size, but the island marker should be larger than the other markers.
